# 2023 EVENTS

The year 2023 was truly filled with achievements and accomplished projects. We are excited to share a few highlights with you.

## JANUARY

Winter Academy "Across the Arbitration Universe: Different Perspectives on Dispute Resolution in the Modern World"

An annual project for experienced arbitration practitioners, featuring world-renowned lecturers. In 2023, the Academy brought together participants from Russia, Kyrgyzstan, Colombia, Nigeria, UK, Rwanda, India, Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina.

#### FEBRUARY

#### New Composition of the RAC Board

Nine new members joined the Board. Among the new members of the Subcommittee on international arbitration are Mohamed Abdel Wahab, Judge Shamlan Al Sawalehi, Olga Boltenko and Islambek Rustambekov.

In February, the RAC supported the National Rounds of the Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition, one of the most famous and prestigious moot courts in the world.

#### MARCH

### New Executive Administrator of the RAC

As of March 1, 2023, Sabina Ganieva became new Executive Administrator of the RAC. Yulia Mullina, who had held this position since 2019, remained Director of the RIMA and RAC and continued to be involved in the RIMA's projects.

#### XIII Moscow Vis Pre-Moot

In 2023, 30 teams, including teams from China, India, France, UK, Ethiopia, Russia, as well as around 90 arbitrators from around the world participated in the online rounds of the Moscow Pre-Moot.

#### JULY

#### Seminar "Arbitrating through the Thorns: How to Conduct International Arbitration Proceedings Nowadays"

In July, RAC jointly with Horizons & Co Law Firm (UAE) held the seminar involving speakers from the largest Russian companies, Russian and foreign lawyers which shared their vision and practical experience in overcoming the current difficulties of conducting international arbitration. The discussions covered various topics, including the issues of finding and engaging foreign lawyers, arbitrators, experts, as well as the role played by the choice of an arbitral institution and seat of arbitration in mitigating the impacts of sanctions.





#### JULY

#### First RAC overseas office in Dubai (DIFC)

In July, the RAC established an office in the Dubai International Financial Centre (DIFC), a free economic zone with its own legal and court system. The RIMA obtained the status of a Recognized Company.



### AUGUST

Summer Academy "Arbitration Vacations: Introduction to Alternative Dispute Resolution"

Summer Academy is an introductory course in Russian on the basics of arbitration. In 2023, the RIMA held it for the forth time in a row.

#### SEPTEMBER

### Discussion "Unraveling Applicable Law in MENA: Strategies, Considerations and RAC Rules Instruments"

The RAC DIFC Office Launch Evening brought together distinguished experts from the MENA region, including Professor Jan Paulsson, Judge Shamlan Al Sawalehi, Anne C. Hoffmann, Adrian Cole, Alec Emmerson.

### Webinar Series "Enigma of Damages in International Commercial and Investment Arbitration"

Webinar series in English that aimed to highlight the intricacies of damages, their varieties, applicable principles, as well as issues associated with the valuation of damages in both investment and commercial disputes.





#### OCTOBER

#### Conference "Arbitration in the Spotlight"

Our in-person international arbitration conference, first in several years, took place in October. More than 100 participants and 25 speakers gathered to discuss the most pressing dispute resolution issues: the right to access to justice, sanctions, ethics, choosing a dispute resolution forum and adapting to current realities.

#### VI FDI Online Pre-Moot

The Foreign Direct Investment International Arbitration Moot (FDI Moot) was preceded by our preliminary online rounds. 24 teams from various countries participated in the rounds, including Argentina, China, Colombia, Egypt, Greece, India, Indonesia, Iran, Kenya, Malaysia, Russia, Singapore, South Africa, Vietnam, and Greece.

#### NOVEMBER

#### Academy for Arbitrators

In the autumn of 2023, we held the first Academy for Arbitrators, an intensive practice-oriented course for professionals wishing to be appointed as arbitrators in the future, as well as for experienced arbitrators who want to improve their knowledge and skills in arbitration.

During the discussion "Exploring Arbitration in the CIS Region", the speakers focused on the arbitration regimes and enforcement of arbitral awards and arbitration agreements in Russia, Belarus, and Uzbekistan. The conference gathered more than 70 participants.

In December, the "Dispute Resolution in the EAEU" competition was held with the support of the RAC. 18 teams from 7 states (the Eurasian Five, as well as Uzbekistan and Sierra Leone) took part in the competition.



The competition is considered to be one of the largest Russian student moot courts and the only Russian competition on arbitration of corporate disputes. In 2023, more than 300 students from various regions of Russia and Belarus, as well as more than 160 arbitrators took part

# RAC BOARD AND EXECUTIVE **ADMINISTRATOR**

The RAC Board is the primary body of the arbitration institute; it is the members of the Board who decide on the appointment, challenges and termination of powers of arbitrators. Therefore, it is of utmost importance for us that the Board is credible to arbitration users and consists of recognised and independent Russian and international experts.

In 2023, significant changes occurred within the RAC Board. Firstly, during rotation, nine new members joined the RAC appointing body. And secondly, a new President of the Board and the President of the Subcommittee on Arbitration of Domestic Disputes were elected.

Additionally, modifications took place in the RAC Administrative Office. In March, the new RAC Executive Administrator was appointed. The Executive Administrator organises the work of the Administrative Office and makes sure that all cases are administered in strict compliance with the provisions of the Arbitration Rules and the best practices.








## ECONOMIC SECTORS OF THE DISPUTES<sup>1</sup><sup>↓</sup> <sup>↓</sup>







# RAC OFFICE IN DUBAI

Since July 2023, the Russian Arbitration Center is the first Russian institution with the overseas office in the Dubai International Financial Centre (DIFC). The Russian Institute of Modern Arbitration has the status of a Recognized Company.

The opening of the office in the MENA region aligns with our vision to make arbitration accessible for the parties: now arbitration users can choose the RAC office in the DIFC in their arbitration clause. The RAC Arbitration Rules 2021 will govern the proceedings, and the arbitration fees provided therein will apply.

RECOMMENDED ARBITRATION CLAUSE



DIFC is a free economic zone with its own legal system which is based on English common law. DIFC also has a separate system of courts which operate in English, follow an arbitration-friendly approach, and can assist and supervise if the DIFC is chosen as the seat of arbitration. DIFC principal currency is the USD.

## INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION


